
Abuse of Power

Example 3: This is a text message Ron Beilke sent to a neighbor who was not a homeowner, revealing he tampered with elections in order to stay in power.




Example 4: The following are examples of Ron Beilke manipulating narratives on social media and dictating to others how to speak.



Yet in response to the annual Villages' Dodgers' Day event the only one response so far was to criticized the HOA for "using HOA money to cover cost of personal interest and luxury." And the worse part is that this comment is completely false and needlessly inflammatory!

As a member of the social committee, I know that the entire cost of this event is \$2250.00 (30 tickets @ \$75.00 each). Of that amount, tickets cost \$1245.00, transportation \$780.00 (including tip, fuel charge and parking) and the remaining \$225.00 for a submarine sandwiches, chips and beverages. The HOA could have charged another \$5.00 per ticket and increased the kitty another \$150.00 but the committee tried to keep the event as reasonable as possible for everyone without costing the HOA a penny!

I just hopes this post clears things up. I completely support this HOA Board that keeps our dues of only \$160 month amazingly low, maintains the property in an excellent and ever improving condition, has fully funded it's Reserve Fund and brings the community a full calendar year of wonderful community events that are overwhelmingly supported and enjoyed by our residents. 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
